RUTH YouthBuild is a leadership development program offering a WASC-accredited high school diploma, hands-on paid vocational training, and comprehensive support grounded in social justice. Participants earn while they learn and graduate with certifications, career skills, and a clear pathway to employment or college.

SECTOR builds technical skills and connects participants to careers in solar, construction, technology, and other growing industries. Our program supports individuals impacted by the justice system through paid training, career placement, and life-skills coaching for long-term success.

Youth Empowerment Zone (YEZ) strengthens youth resilience through family engagement, leadership development, and emotional wellness workshops. Participants build positive futures by learning conflict resolution, life skills, and community leadership to navigate adolescence and beyond.

Re-Entry Action for Youth (RAY) Supports youth reentry through mentorship, resource access, and lived experience guidance. Participants gain stability with help in housing, education, jobs, and wellness while building trust, accountability, and paths to long-term success.

Community Violence Intervention (CVI) connects youth and young adults impacted by violence with crisis response, mediation, support services, and peace-building resources. We help individuals heal, rebuild, and lead positive change within their neighborhoods.

House of RUTH is a transitional reentry program for adults rebuilding after incarceration. The House of RUTH provides stable housing, personal and professional development services, mentorship, and workforce support to empower a successful reentry into the community.
